

**East Chapel Hill High School Alumni Association
Annual Report
2009-2010**

This report signifies an accounting of the activities of the East Chapel Hill High School Alumni Association (the "Association") for the year beginning February 16, 2009, concluding February 15, 2010.

February 16th is chosen as the start date for the Association's year, as its 2009 occurrence represents the effective drafting date of the Association's bylaws.

SECTION I -- *Bylaws*

Bylaws to govern both the structural form and procedural function of the Association were drafted on February 16th by Mr. Nooree Lee, Association President. These were disseminated to the acting Board of Directors on March 5th, and adopted by general consent of the Board within the same month. In accordance with terms of the Bylaws, acting Directors became official Directors via appointment by Mr. Lee. These individuals include: Ms. Lauren Pozefsky, Ms. Elizabeth Hodge, Ms. Sabrina Borst and Mr. Dana DiMaio, in addition to Mr. Lee.

SECTION II -- *Board Actions*

The Board conducted two meetings during the year, the first held on October 29th, the second February 7th. Both meetings were conducted via tele-conference.

Projects the Board voted to undertake at the October meeting include: (i) incorporation of the Association within the State of North Carolina, (ii) production of a database of East Chapel Hill High School alumni, (iii) presentation of an alumni fair for current East Chapel Hill High School students.

The February meeting saw the Board amend the aims of aforementioned Project III, limiting its intended scope to bringing an individual alumnus/a with a specific message to the school at variable intervals.

SECTION III -- *Outreach*

The principal outreach activity undertaken by the Association during the year was setting up a donation page on the American Cancer Society's website in honor of ex-principal David Thaden.

SECTION IV -- *Finances*

The East Chapel Hill High School Parent Teacher Student Association (PTSA) allocated \$500 to the Association on March 3rd for general funding. Due to the Association remaining unincorporated through the end of the year, these funds have yet to be deposited. It is likely premature to speculate on whether said funds would be re-allocated upon Association incorporation.

Owing to the above, Mr. Lee funded the Association out-of-pocket during the year. He allocated \$30 (discretionary funds) each to two student liaisons working for the Association, and contributed \$45 to the operational status of the Association's website.

SECTION V -- *Personnel*

On October 21st, the Association extended an offer for the position of Student Liaison to Ms. Yuyi Li, who accepted. She joined the previously-hired Student Liaison, Ms. Lori Kim.

Ms. Hodge resigned her position of Director on February 7th; a new Director had yet to be appointed to the position by Mr. Lee before the year's close.
